Examiner's Amendment

Claims 1, 4-6 and 9-11 are hereby cancelled.

Reasons for NIRC Action

A non-final office action was mailed by the USPTO on May 23, 2022, setting a two month

shortened statutory period of reply. No response was received. Under the provisions of 37 CFR

§1.550 (c), even a response containing only a time extension would have to have been submitted
